Welcome Everyone! – Happy 55th Birthday to NCCC!

The church was first established in 1971 as a fellowship (Nottingham Chinese Christian Fellowship (NCCF)). The Chinese Overseas Christian Mission (COCM) has been instrumental in supporting us to date. Inauguration of the Nottingham Chinese Christian Church (NCCC) took place on 8th May 1994 (hence we celebrate our anniversary on the Sunday closest to 8th May every year!). NCCC became a registered UK charity in the same year. On 2nd October 2023, NCCC registered as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO). The Lord has added numbers to our congregation in recent years. As of 7th April 2024, NCCC relocated from St Nic's Church to West Bridgford Baptist Church for our Sunday and some midweek gatherings. We launched a new governance structure last year which includes the Chinese, English and Administrative divisions. We are now blessed with the provision of one full-time and one half-time church ministers and two associate ministers.

We are most grateful to the prayers and support from our mission partners/organisations, including COCM and our own missionaries Thorsten and Kertsin Prills.

It is our pleasure to welcome our guests to come to give thanks and to share a great joy with us today, including our speaker Rev. Addson Chan from Evangel Seminary, Rev Stephen McKibbin, Minister of WBBC, and David Wells, former advisor to NCCC.
