Biography

Wai Hung Andy Fan came to faith during his high-school years and has since been actively involved in various church ministries, serving as a church deacon for fourteen years. After graduating from secondary school, he entered the medical equipment distribution industry, specialising in engineering project management. While working, he continued his studies and obtained a Professional Diploma in Information Technology from the Hong Kong Management Association, a Diploma in Biblical Studies from the Divinity School of Chung Chi College, The Chinese University of Hong Kong, and a Master's degree in Engineering Management from the University of Technology Sydney.

In 2014, he responded to God's calling and entered Bethel Bible Seminary for theological training, completing his Bachelor of Theology degree in 2018. After graduation, he served at his home church, The Wing Kong Pentecostal Holiness Church, and later at C&MA Riviera Gardens Alliance Church, focusing primarily on ministry to couples and men's groups.

In early 2023, he and his wife relocated to the United Kingdom. Remaining faithful to his calling, he continues to serve Hong Kong families who have settled in the UK, regularly hosting Bible study groups and family Sunday worship gatherings in their home.

Family Background

Andy married Yuk Fan Tsoi in 1991. They have two sons, both of whom married in 2021 and 2023 respectively and currently reside in Hong Kong.
