- Finding a home: Praise the Lord and thank you for your prayers. Kerstin and Thorsten have found a suitable flat to rent in Exmouth. Give thanks for the support they have received, especially the generosity and hospitality shown by the brothers and sisters at Christ Church Exmouth.
- Anglican Convocation Synod: Pray for Thorsten and Kerstin as they prepare to attend the Synod of the Anglican Convocation in Europe in Manchester (3–5 September).
