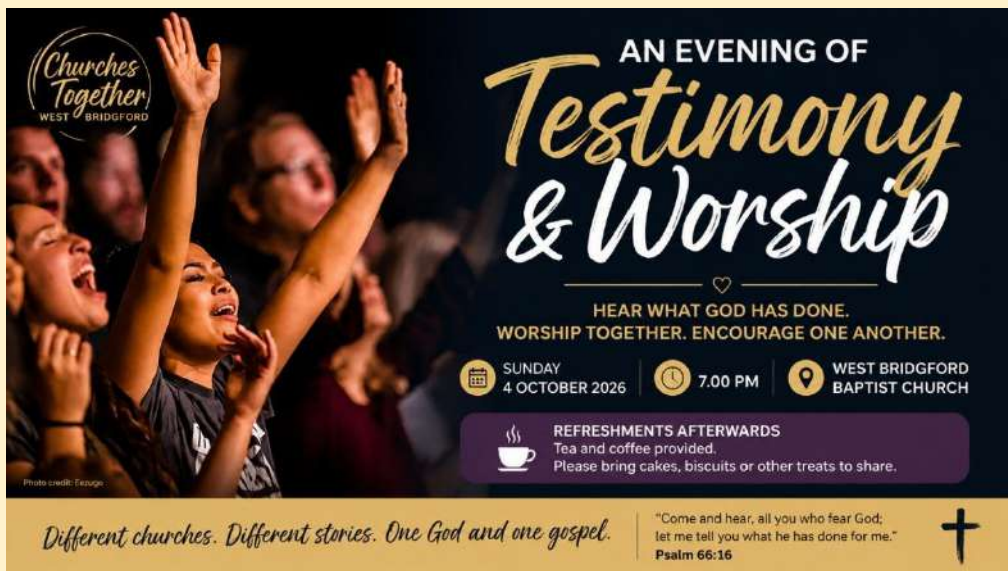
Next Generation Ministries Arrangements in the New Term
