Introduction: The theme of “Yet Not I But Through Christ In Me” is rooted in Galatians 2:20. In Paul’s letter to the church of Galatia, he was urging the church to understand that his transformation from being someone who persecuted Christians to fervently preaching Christianity to others was not by his own power, but by the power of Jesus Christ. He also wanted the church to experience the joy and freedom of being transformed by Jesus. He ends the letter by saying that he was to boast nothing but the cross of Jesus. Everything he did was in, for and through Christ Jesus. Do you want the power of Jesus, which drove the impossible transform in Paul, to transform you daily?
